Camp Bon Temps Amenities



We have 8 cabins located throughout the camp property, 2 pavilions, canoe dock, volleyball, swimming pool, and archery area.

K-hut 1 & 2 are our most popular cabins. These two cabins sleep 7 (beds in cabins) each and have A/C units. They are located in the front of the property, near the Lodge. Each cabin has a fire ring nearby and picnic tables. K-hut 1 does have a ramp and is the **only** cabin that is handicap accessible.

Eagle, Rabbit & Squirrel are 3 of our smaller, screened in huts. It sleeps 5 (beds in cabins) each with no A/C units, and is located in the middle of the property. There are two fire rings nearby with picnic tables. There is also room for about 2 – 3 small tents to be put up in this area.

Pavilion 1 is located nearby the 3 small huts and crawfish pot. This area is great for tent camping; it has 3 fire rings, large fire place under the pavilion with 7 picnic tables, making this a great place for outdoor activities and arts & crafts. The volleyball area is next to this area for easy access for the girls.

Crawfish Pot is a bath house in the middle of the property, and we do provide paper goods (toilet paper & hand towels). This bath house has 2 shower stalls and 3 toilets. This building is handicap accessible.

The Big House sit off by itself. It sleeps 10 (no beds), no A/C (just screen windows with fans). There is a fire ring and picnic table located near the cabin. Located in the middle of the camp.

Cajun & Creole are screened in cabins that sleep 10 (no beds) with no A/C (just screen windows with fans). Located near the back of the camp, they have one fire ring and 2 picnic tables nearby. These 2 cabins are located next to each other, making them great for a large group.

Pavilion 2 is located near Cajun & Creole cabins. This area is great for tent camping, has 2 fire rings, and a large fireplace under the pavilion with 6 picnic tables. This a great place for outdoor activities and arts & crafts.

Golden Pond is a large bath house near Cajun & Creole cabins. It has 3 shower stalls, 6 toilets, and paper goods are supplied.

Swimming Pool is located in the front of the camp property by the lodge. The pool is open from May 15 through Oct 15 for our campers to use. You must schedule to use the pool and provide your own lifeguard. The lifeguard must be certified (1 lifeguard per 25 people) and a copy of their certification needs to be given to the Site Manager. Pool maximum is 50 people. It is recommended to wear swimming shoes or socks.

Canoeing is always a fun activity for the girls. Our manmade lake is located in the very back of the property. S must be trained in canoeing through our council to host this activity. Everyone is required to wear a life jacket when on the dock or in a canoe. No boots, only shoes, in case of canoe tipping over.

Island is located in the back of the property. The challenge for our canoers is to go around the island and back to the dock. The island is also our chapel area for peace and quiet, and has a small triangle shaped amphitheater that can be used. Primitive tent camping is welcome on the island, which has 1 fire ring. There is no electricity on the island, nor bathrooms.

Archery is another fun activity for the girls to take part in at camp. Our archery area is in the front of the camp, just past the K-huts. Someone must be trained in archery through our council to host this activity.

Volleyball area for the girls helps to pass the time and to teach team working skills.

Lodge/Activity Area is a spacious area with a fireplace located at the front of the property and can be used to host a variety of activities.

Kitchen area is located at the front of the property within the lodge and houses what one would need for all their ktichen needs: refrigerator/freezer, sink, utensils/plates, etc. Speak with a Site Manager for more details.
