General Camp Information

Camp terms and conditions:

- 1. Parents must be aware that camp will be on a first-come first-served basis.
- 2. The payment of the deposit or full payment enrolls the camper to the selected period of the camp program.
- 3. No refunds on camp fees will be given except in the case of infectious illness. In case of illness, a doctor's note must be provided within the week of the camp start date. The note must clearly state the camper cannot attend due to an illness. Fifty percent of the camp fee will be refunded in these cases when requested, as camp teams will have made non-refundable purchases by this time.
- 4. All medical conditions of the camper must be stated on the health history form concisely and clearly.
- 5. Campers must bring the recommended gear/clothing for the specific camp that shall be required by the camp team or the council.
- 6. The camper should bring her rain gear, bug repellent, and sunblock cream upon admission to the camp.
- 7. The camp shall not accept responsibility for the loss or damage to any property belonging to the campers.
- 8. Mobile Phones, tablets, smartwatches, ipods, etc., are prohibited at camp. If these items are brought to camp, a camper's family will be contacted to retrieve the item. This is a safety rule for the girls and to protect the camper's valuables. The council and camp volunteers are not responsible for lost or stolen valuables.
- 9. Cameras are permitted, provided that it does not contain any communication feature via internet or mobile phone services. Photographs and videos are allowed to be taken with the permission of those being photographed as long as it does not disturb the activity of the other campers.
- 10. The camp's staff may take photos or videos while in the camp's activities and may use such photos or videos for promotional purposes. However, you may inform camp volunteer upon check-in if you do not wish for images of your camper to be used.
- 11. The guardian authorizes the Camp to seek medical treatment in the event of an accident or sickness. It is likewise the Camp's responsibility to inform the parents/guardians of the camper in case such an event arises at the earliest time possible for the Camp's volunteers to notify the parents or guardians.
- 12. The schedule of activities is subject to change depending on weather conditions, program schedule, and other arrangements by which the Camp reserves the right to cancel, amend or alter activities accordingly in the event of unanticipated situations.

Cookie Dough:

Your registration will not be valid until you've paid any remaining balance after cookie dough is applied. Cookie dough should be processed within 2-4 business days. You will receive a call/email from council with next steps. Cookie Dough earned from the 2023 Cookie Season will not be available for use until April. Only applicable to registered GSLPG members.

Juliette Funds (IRM):

Your registration will not be valid until you've paid any remaining balance after Juliette Funds are applied to the total. Processing Juliette Funds may take up to 5 business days. Only applicable to Individually Registered Girls at GSLPG.

Financial Aid:

Please be aware when selecting Financial Assistance as a payment type that FA is both limited in amount and restricted based on the funding source (ex. restricted grants). This means that FA is never guaranteed and may not be available to you based on your region or the camp you are attending. Only applicable to registered girl members of GSLPG. Residences of certain parishes may be elligible for additional financial aid due to restricted grant funding.

All entries are reviewed for accuracy. If it is determined afterward that you are ineligible for this FA, the council will reach out to collect the balance of the FA that was used, and your summer camp registration will not be valid until you have paid the full amount owed.




June 12-16, 2023 | Day Camp D-J \$125.00 | Aides C-A \$63.00 | Tagalongs \$30.00


Tagalongs are for weeklong volunteers. Tagalongs must be potty trained.

June 26-29, 2023 | Day Camp J-A | 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. | \$80.00


