Camp Wawbansee Amenities



Pine Ridge – consists of 7 cabins that will sleep 24 campers. One cabin is handicap accessible. These cabins have electricity but no heat and air. There is a pavilion with fireplace and fire ring for this camp area. Firewood is provided. This area shares a full bath house with Fern Ridge.

Fern Ridge – consists of 9 cabins that will sleep 32 campers. These cabins have electricity but no heat and air. There is a pavilion and a fire ring for this camp area, and firewood is provided. This area shares a full bath house with Pine Ridge.

Persimmon Hill – consists of 8 cabins that will sleep 28 campers. This area has its own designated bath house, a pavilion with fireplace, and a fire ring with firewood provided.

Tent Camping - located between Pine and Fern Ridge (you must bring your own tent).

Arts & Crafts Building – located across from Dining Hall and consists of tables and area for the campers to design and create projects.

Lake – we have a picturesque lake that is used for canoeing and fishing. We have a dock and all persons are required to wear a life jacket if they are going on the dock or canoeing. We have several canoes for our campers to use, but they must have an adult who is certified through Girl Scouts for canoeing.

Archery – this area is set up away from the cabins. We can set up to 3 targets at a time to be used to train girls on how to use a bow and arrow. The instructor must be certified through Girl Scout to use this area. We do provide the bows and arrows.

Pool – we have a pool on location. The pool is normally open from May through August. To have use of the pool, the Troop/SU must provide a lifeguard with copy of certification directly to the site manager before use.

Parking Lot – the parking lot is just to the right of The Dining Hall across from the Arts & Crafts Building, where we store our new Wagon carts. We do have Dusk to Dawn lighting throughout the camp at night. No vehicles are allowed past the Dining Hall without permission from Site Manager. Carts are available to carry your items to the cabin/area where you are staying.

NO Alcohol is allowed on the property. If any is found in your possession, you will be asked to leave. No smoking is allowed on the property, if caught smoking on the property, you will be asked to leave. Effective January 1, 2018 anytime inclement weather occurs and temperatures are below freezing the camp will be closed. You will have to reschedule sorry for the inconvenience.
