	Find the U.S. Space Force base located closest to your hometown. Name and describe the mission of this base. Who is the Commander of this base? When was the base established? Listen to and sing the Space Force song. Try searching online or at the library. What department of the military does the Space Force fall under? Discover what is so special about the U.S. Space Force. When was it established? Discover who are the current members of the Joint Chiefs of Staff? Name and describe the priorities of the Space Force.
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	Invite a member of the United States Space Force to visit your troop or interview them. Have them explain what their role in the Space Force is. Ask them to explain some of the differences between the Space Force and other branches of the military. Ask them some of the places you can be stationed while in the Space Force. Is this something you would like to do? Invite the spouse or a child of a Space Force member to visit your troop meeting and/or interview them. What is it like to have a family member in the Space Force? Where have they lived? How does their life differ from

	Visit an air and space museum.
