2,865 cookie CEOs sold **888,299** boxes of cookies.

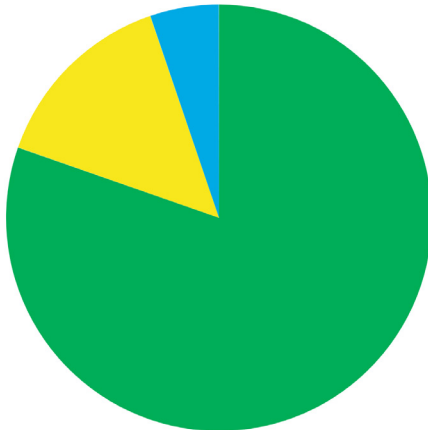
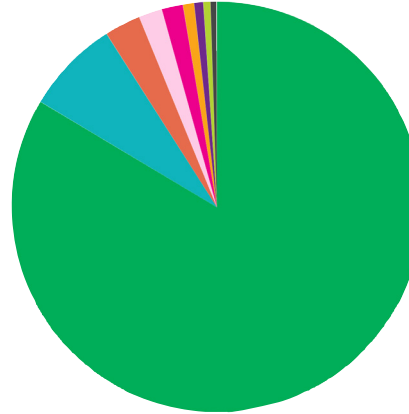
