

Safety During COVID-19 Checklist



Before Arrival to Camp/Activity

- All attendees must follow all guidance in the most recent version of the “GSLPG Volunteer COVID-19 Guidance.”
- All attendees should take the “Attendee Pre-Screening and Symptom Checker” test prior to attending camp/activity (Hygiene and COVID-19 Risk Mitigation).
- Social distancing is highly recommended.
- Masks are no longer required for fully vaccinated individuals.
- Masks are highly recommended for un-vaccinated individuals.
- Do not allow the following persons to attend camp/activities: (1) those who have had COVID-19 symptoms in the previous two weeks, someone who has been in contact with a person who is exhibiting/has COVID-19 symptoms, and (3) someone who has been to a high-risk geographical region (Hygiene and COVID-19 Risk Mitigation).
- Ensure maximum number of attendees is not exceeded.

Arrival

- Safe drop off protocols should be followed (Drop-off, Pick-up, & Transportation Process).
- Upon drop-off, attendees should be pre-screened with temperature checks and symptom questions. Those who exhibit symptoms should not be allowed to attend (Hygiene and COVID-19 Risk Mitigation).
- Utilize the “Cohort Tracking Sheet” for sign in and to assign girls to small cohorts. This document must be kept on record with COVID-19 waivers (Creating Cohorts).
- Prior to beginning, conduct a quick training on hygiene and respiratory etiquette (Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette), personal contact (Personal Contact), social distancing, and mask wearing (Face Coverings), and who to report to if feeling ill with COVID-19 symptoms.

During

- At the end of the day, utilize the “Camp Cleaning Checklist” to ensure proper cleaning during COVID-19 (Cleaning and Disinfection).
- Limit sharing of supplies.

- Ensure everyone is following Hygiene and COVID-19 Risk Mitigation protocols and Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette.

Symptoms While at Camp/Activity

- If an attendee reports exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, immediately quarantine the person away from other attendees (Isolation Measures).
- Ensure proper adult supervision while isolated. Contact the parent immediately for pickup (Isolation Measures).
- Close off the area used by the affected girl and open outside doors and windows to increase air circulation (Isolation Measures).
- If at camp, contact the Site Manager for further instruction. Provide the Site Manager with the Cohort list (Isolation Measures).
- If outside of camp for GS activity, contact your Troop Support Specialist for further instruction. Provide the Troop Support/Membership Specialist with the Cohort list (Isolation Measures).
- Follow all guidance listed under “Reporting and Communicating a Positive COVID-19 Test.”

Symptoms After Camp (Up to 3 days after)

- Promptly contact your Troop Support/Membership Specialist (Reporting and Communicating a Positive COVID-19 Test, pgs. 6/7) and follow all guidance listed under “Reporting and Communicating a Positive COVID-19 Test (pgs. 6/7).”
