

Girl Scouts aged 17 and younger are eligible to open a Team Pelican Youth Savings Account, which includes:

- Savings that grow automatically—up to 1%¹
- 24/7 access through MyPelican
- Annual scholarships and award eligibility
- Chance to earn up to \$10 per A on semester-end report cards

Rates and account features are subject to change at any time, even after the account is opened. Advertised APY of 1.00% is the highest for Team Pelican Youth Savings Accounts. Pelican reserves the right to limit the number of accounts allowed per member, joint or individually. Other account transfer and withdrawal limitations may apply. Team Pelican savings accounts are federally insured by NCUA.

Since 2018, Pelican has partnered with Girl Scout Troops across Louisiana to teach financial wellness to Girl Scouts.

Girl Scout Troops are invited to tour their local Pelican branch to learn more about financial wellness and credit unions.

The tours include a Financial Wellness Workshop, introductions to branch staff members with explanations of their job duties, and demonstrations of branch processes and technology.

These demonstrations include:

- A presentation of the cash recyclers and how they're used to take out and deposit money into accounts.
- A visit to the bank vault with an explanation of what it is.
- A visit to the Video Teller Machine and chat with the Video Teller to learn more about the devices.

The Girl Scouts offer their own badges for financial education courses. We have developed financial wellness presentations to correspond with the badges offered by the Girl Scouts. Below is the list of Financial Wellness Badges offered by the Girl Scouts and the corresponding Pelican Workshop that fulfills those educational requirements:

The badge can be placed on the back of their smock or sash per Girl Scout regulations!

Once the tour is complete, each attendee will receive a small snack, a gift bag with Pelican goodies, and an exclusive Pelican Financial Wellness Badge.

We love Girl Scouts cookies as much as everyone else! As part of our partnership, Pelican will work with the Girl Scouts to organize a Girl Scouts Cookie Day at Pelican. On this day, Pelican will allow troops to set up tables at Pelican branches across the state to sell their cookies.

We'll even help with the marketing! Our team will market this single-day event through our social media and other platforms to drive traffic to the branches.

Pelican will also provide materials to the Girl Scout Troops so that they can let everyone know they'll be at Pelican selling cookies.

You'll gain access to parental controls to ease your mind while they get benefits like:

- Annual scholarships and award eligibility.1
- Chance to earn up to \$10 per A on semester-end report cards.
- Real-time account monitoring alerts you every time your teen's card is used.
- A \$500/day purchase limit on their debit card and a \$105/day ATM limit.
- Card controls to easily disable your teen's card in the MyPelican app in case they lose it.

¹Pelican State CU membership eligibility required. Adults 18 years old or older must be joint account holders on the child's Team Pelican youth savings account. The joint account holder must provide a form of identification for themself and the child, such as a birth certificate or Social Security card, to open an account. The highest attainable grade on the report card pertains to each individual semester-end report card's grading scale. Maximum of \$35 per semester-end report card for Team Pelican accounts (\$5 per A) and \$70 per semester if the student also has an active Pelican Teen Checking account (\$10 per A). Copy of official semester-end report card required. Only the student's most recent semester-end report card is accepted. Report cards are accepted for either of the major semesters, such as May-end and December-end, or terms, such as spring or fall terms. Report cards must be dated after the membership open date. Report cards presented with dates before the membership open date are ineligible. Team Pelican savings accounts are federally insured by NCUA.
